3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

Other social work activities without accommodation n.e.c.. To promote social welfare activities for the benefit of the general public without any discrimination of caste, creed, religion, gender or economic status, and to undertake initiatives relating to education, healthcare, livelihood generation, community development and social upliftment.

To work for the upliftment and empowerment of economically weaker sections of society including women, children, senior citizens, widows, orphans and differently-abled persons by providing financial assistance, education, skill development, rehabilitation and social support.

To establish, run, maintain, support and grant aid to schools, colleges, training institutes, orphanages, old age homes, rehabilitation centers, shelters, and other institutions for the promotion of education, care, protection and welfare of the society.

To organize, conduct and promote programs, workshops, seminars and campaigns for

poverty alleviation, vocational training, skill development, self-employment, entrepreneurship and rural as well as urban development.

To provide medical relief and healthcare services by organizing health camps, blood donation camps, awareness drives, sanitation programs, disease prevention initiatives and by supporting hospitals, clinics and healthcare institutions.

To promote women empowerment and gender equality through education, awareness, training, legal support and capacity building programs, and to work towards elimination of discrimination, violence and social injustice against women.

To provide relief and assistance to the poor, needy and affected persons during natural calamities such as floods, earthquakes, droughts, pandemics or any other disasters, and to undertake rehabilitation and relief measures.

To promote environmental protection, ecological balance, cleanliness, sanitation, waste management, water conservation, renewable energy and sustainable development through awareness and implementation of projects.

To collaborate, associate, coordinate and work in partnership with Central Government, State Governments, local authorities, statutory bodies, public sector undertakings, private sector companies, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), international organizations, trusts, societies and other institutions for planning, implementing and promoting social welfare, charitable,

educational, healthcare, environmental and humanitarian projects.

Further, to receive grants, donations, CSR funds and financial or technical assistance, and to enter into agreements, MOUs or partnerships for effective implementation and management of such projects and programs.

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To undertake, implement and promote Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities in accordance with applicable laws and to act as an implementing agency for CSR projects of companies and organizations. The objects of the Company shall be carried out without any profit motive and any income or property of the Company shall be applied solely for the promotion of its objects.?

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

To acquire, purchase, take on lease, hire or otherwise obtain any movable or immovable property, land, buildings, infrastructure or facilities as may be necessary or convenient for the furtherance of the objects of the Company and to construct, maintain, alter or improve the same.

To accept, receive, collect and raise funds, donations, grants, aids, subscriptions, endowments, gifts, contributions and financial assistance from individuals, institutions, companies, government bodies or international organizations, whether in cash or kind, for the promotion of the objects of the Company.

To open, operate and maintain bank accounts of any kind with any bank or financial institution and to deposit, withdraw, invest or utilize funds of the Company in such manner as may be

deemed fit for achieving its objects.

To invest and deal with the funds of the Company not immediately required in such manner as may be permitted under applicable laws, and to vary or realize such investments as may be considered necessary.

To appoint, employ, engage or otherwise take the services of professionals, consultants, advisors, staff, volunteers or experts and to pay remuneration, honorarium or reimburse expenses for services rendered in furtherance of the objects of the Company.

To organize, conduct, participate and assist in conferences, seminars, workshops, training programs, awareness campaigns, exhibitions and other events for promoting the objectives of the Company.

To print, publish, issue, distribute or circulate newsletters, magazines, books, pamphlets, reports or any other publications in physical or digital form for spreading awareness and promoting the objects of the Company.

To enter into agreements, contracts, collaborations, partnerships or arrangements with any person, organization or authority, whether in India or abroad, for carrying out the objects of the Company effectively.

To apply for, obtain, register, purchase or otherwise acquire any licenses, permissions, approvals, registrations or rights from any government or statutory authority as may be required for achieving the objects of the Company.

To incur expenditure and to do all such acts, deeds and things as are necessary or incidental for

the attainment of the main objects of the Company.

To establish branches, offices, centers or units at various places in India or abroad for the efficient carrying out of the activities of the Company.

To maintain proper books of accounts, records and documents and to ensure transparency, accountability and compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

To borrow or raise funds, if necessary, in such manner as permitted under law for the objects of the Company, provided that such borrowing shall not be inconsistent with the charitable nature of the Company.

To undertake all such lawful activities as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects and which are not inconsistent with the provisions of Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013.

the doing of all such other lawful things as considered necessary for the furtherance of the above objects:

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudence remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

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9 True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the company and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits and liabilities of the company; and, subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the company for the time being in force, the accounts shall be open to the inspection of the members. Once at least in every year, the accounts of the company shall be examined, and the correctness of the balance-sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors

10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.

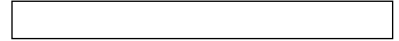
